Why an AA in Transfer Studies?

An AA in Transfer Studies is an especially excellent choice for students who intend to transfer to a four-year school, in certain majors.

With an AA in Transfer Studies, the classes you take in your major, or program of study, can be customized for your transfer institution.

In the Program of Accelerated College Completion, you will select a major and perhaps a minor, and in your second year at LCC you will take classes in your major and/or minor, with maximum transferability to your transfer institution of choice. This will eliminate the possibility of taking classes via an Associates of Arts in a specific discipline (as opposed to the more general "Transfer Studies") that do not transfer to your selected transfer institution. Please consult with an Academic Advisor to assure that you take no classes that do not transfer.

For students intending to transfer to a four-year school, typical majors within an AA (Associate of Arts) in Transfer Studies might include: Business, Accounting, Management, Social Science (Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, Political Science, Education, etc.), Humanities (History, Theater, Art, Religious Studies, etc.), English, Journalism, Creative Writing, and so on. In contrast, transfer students considering Math, Science, Computer, and Pre-Health majors, would instead work to obtain an AS (Associate of Science) in Transfer Studies.
