

Graphic Design Curriculum Meeting

Objective: To begin discussions on aligning the new Graphic Communications Curriculum with the current curriculum 0219 to ensure that all learning outcome of the current curriculum are met in the new curriculum.

We began our meeting by reviewing the Old/New Curriculum email sent out by Brian, discussing the new courses and what courses would be revised and which courses would be discontinued, with the content being redistributed into current courses.

We reviewed the proposed semester outline (4 semesters and a summer) to complete the new Graphic Communications Degree and how those classes may Or may not fit together, sequentially.

We discussed how we will begin our next meeting reviewing the learning outcomes Of each course in the Graphic Communications Curriculum to ensure that all outcomes are being met throughout the curriculum and that those objectives are consistent within the EISD curriculums AND how we redistribute outcomes from courses that are no longer being offered, such as the ARTS 257 Prepress course. (Susie and Connie will coordinate to have all course syllabus present at next meeting.) We also encouraged faculty to bring copies of their own syllabus that they use in their courses to share.

The group felt that we would like to have our team leader present at the next meeting, as he has a greater understand of the "big" picture as to where the program, as a whole, is headed, and we need that direction to be successful in our meetings.
