Curriculum Code: 1296 (Effective Fall 2009 – Summer 2014)

The Instrument Rated Private Pilot License certificate provides all required ground and in-flight technical training to meet Federal Aviation Administration requirements for Private Pilot Certification with an Instrument Rating. This program will build on the previous experience of the student. Students entering this program are required to accomplish an F.A.A. Class II medical exam prior to entering the training. Normal motor skills and academic ability will provide functional competency to support certification.
