Description

This certificate curriculum is designed to introduce students to the skills necessary for a pharmacy technician position in a hospital or retail pharmacy. Students will be prepared to function with knowledge and accuracy in preparing, dispensing and control of drugs in either setting. Upon successful completion, students are prepared for the technical portion of the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board National Certification Exam. Review of certification and exam requirements, along with additional requirements, will be needed prior to taking the exam.

Students must complete all courses with a minimum grade of 2.5 to receive this certificate.

Students wishing to pursue an associate degree, should declare the Allied Health A.A.S. major. Courses in this program of study may be applied toward that degree.
