

Assurance of Quality

Lansing Community College offers assurance to its students; prospective employers; and receiving transfer colleges, universities, and technical training institutions, that individuals who have earned LCC degrees or certificates are competent to perform in their areas of major study.

Transferring students who have earned an official Lansing Community College certificate or degree should be able to perform competently in the area in which they majored or specialized at Lansing Community College.

Non-transferring students who have earned an official Lansing Community College certificate or degree should be able to perform competently in the area in which they majored or specialized at Lansing Community College.

A Lansing Community College graduate may be permitted to retake a specified course or courses, when next offered, with no tuition or fee charge by submitting his or her request to the Registrar's Office along with supporting documentation from the institution to which he or she has transferred or from his or her employer, whichever is appropriate.

Because unused skills and knowledge can decay rapidly, the assurances offered herein will be in effect for one year from the date the course or courses in question were taken at Lansing Community College.
