DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT LANSING COMMUNITY COLLEGE / UNIVERSITY OF DETROIT MERCY

Lansing Community College and the University of Detroit Mercy agree that any student who has earned an Associate in Applied Science Degree from Lansing Community College's Dental Hygiene program and who has followed the attached Lansing Community College / University of Detroit Mercy curriculum plan, may transfer a maximum of 92.5 semester hours of credit. Such credits will apply to the Bachelor of Science degree in Dental Hygiene at the University of Detroit Mercy. The University of Detroit Mercy program is designed so that the Lansing Community College student who follows the attached Lansing Community College program outline can complete the University of Detroit Mercy degree requirements within 1 additional year of full time studies (approximately 1 Fall and 1 Winter semester of 15 credit hours each and 1 PreSummer/Summer semester of 3.5 credit hours). It is also understood that courses with less than a "C" grade will not transfer for credit or placement.

Lansing Community College and the University of Detroit Mercy agree to cooperate in communication with each other and with common and respective publics concerning the relationship between the Dental Hygiene Program at Lansing Community College and the Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene Program at the University of Detroit Mercy. Communication will include the development of advising materials and various kinds of publications to inform prospective students who might benefit personally or professionally from the opportunities of a Bachelor's degree program in Dental Hygiene based on the Associate Degree in Applied Science Program at Lansing Community College.

Lansing Community College and the University of Detroit Mercy agree to identify an individual at each institution to evaluate the continuing effectiveness of this agreement, to facilitate the change and development of the program and to advise students in exceptional situations.

This document will be reviewed in 2016 and every five (5) years thereafter.

The agreement will become effective on the date of the signing and shall remain in effect until such time as either party wishes to terminate. Notice of termination shall be given in writing at least 90 days prior to the effective date of termination. The agreement shall be honored for two academic years immediately following the notification to terminate so students currently under the agreement may finish their plan of study.

BIOL 145 Intro Anatomy and Physiology 4 credits

OR

BIOL 201 Human Anatomy 4 credits

AND

BIOL 201 Human Physiology 4 credits

Due to this, the acceptable credit hours will be adjusted to:

With BIOL 145 – 27 hours prerequisites for a total of 84.5 credit hours

With BIOL 201 and BIOL 202 – 31 hours prerequisites for a total of 88.5 credit hours
