

## **Nursing: GPA Calculator**

Follow the instructions below to calculate your Nursing GPA. The complete point system is available in the Nursing <u>Advising Guide</u> (www.lcc.edu/hhs/advising-guides.html).

- **1.** Enter the credit amount for each class you completed. If a course transferred in, view your LCC unofficial transcript to determine how many credits were awarded.
  - \*If you did not complete a course or it was waived by a degree or AP exam, <u>leave the credit</u>, <u>grade</u>, <u>and quality point fields blank</u>.
- **2.** Enter your highest earned grade (within 2 attempts) for each course you completed. \*If you did not complete a course or it was waived by a degree or AP exam, <u>leave the credit</u>, <u>grade</u>, <u>and quality point fields blank</u>.
  - \*\*If a course transferred into LCC from a college that uses letter grades, use the grading scale found on page 2 of the Nursing <u>Advising Guide</u>.
- **3.** For each course, calculate the quality points by multiplying the credit amount by the grade. For example, a 4 credit class with a 3.5 grade would equal 14 quality points for that class. CREDIT X GRADE = QUALITY POINTS
- **4.** Add all of the credits together to determine the total amount of credits.
- **5.** Add all of the quality points together to determine the total amount of quality points.
- **6.** Divide the total quality points by the total credit amount to get your Nursing GPA. TOTAL QUALITY POINTS / TOTAL CREDITS = NURSING GPA
