Revised Course Proposals:

CHDV 100 - Foundations Early Childhood Ed

The Child Development and Early Education Program (Health & Human Services Division) stated that CHDV 100 (Foundations Early Childhood Ed) is being revised because the course learning outcomes have been updated and revised to align with current industry standards, including the National Association for the Education of Young Children, Michigan Core Knowledge and Core Competencies, and best practices in the field. The CC recommends the revised course proposal for CHDV 100 (Foundations Early Childhood Ed) move forward as a recommendation to the Academic Senate.

CHDV 215 - Infant Toddler Program Dev

The Child Development and Early Education Program (Health & Human Services Division) stated that CHDV 215 (Infant Toddler Program Dev) is being revised because the course learning outcomes have been updated and revised to align with current industry standards, including the National Association for the Education of Young Children, Michigan Core Knowledge and Core Competencies, and best practices in the field. Because of this realignment there has been a reduction in lecture content, lecture hours, and credit hours. The CC recommends the revised course proposal for CHDV 215 (Infant Toddler Program Dev) move forward as a recommendation to the Academic Senate.

CHDV 222 - School-Age: Out of School Care

The Child Development and Early Education Program (Health & Human Services Division) stated that CHDV 222 (School-Age: Out of School Care) is being revised because the course title and learning outcomes have been updated and revised to align with current industry standards and best practices in the field. The CC recommends the revised course proposal for CHDV 222 (School-Age: Out of School Care) move forward as a recommendation to the Academic Senate.
