HUMS 140, HUMS 215, and PHYS 200 – Transferability standards (Mary Ellen/Rafeeq)	3:05-3:15 2:38-2:52	 Transferability for these three courses does not meet our MTA requirement of direct/equivalent transfer to a minimum of four of our Top 7 Public Transfer Partners. Rafeeq and Mary Ellen requested Cheryl to check with those non-accepted schools. If not reaching the minimum four, they will need to be removed from MTA site. Zachary Foster says if removed from MTA, these courses can count for students following a program pathway of Fall 21 or earlier. Most likely we will count these courses even if taken after removal from the list, until the particular program's expiry. For programs of Fall 2022 forward they would not be an option. Rafeeq would like to AA to talk about a minimum to qualify. Rather than current direct transfer/equivalent transfer to 4 of our Top 7 Public Transfer Partners? Or maybe either one or the other? (A couple non-public schools actually take more of our transfer students than some of the public schools.) Rafeeq will get updated transfer data from Holly Locke.
