Concurrent enrollment in college-level classes is required. Students should meet with an academic advisor to determine which concurrent enrollment options to select. (F,Sp,Su) Prerequisite Course: None Placement Scores: Reading Level 2 and Writing Level 2 Concurrent enrollment in a ACAD 100 or BUSN 118 or PSYC 200 or SOCL 120 is required. See an academic advisor for a complete listing of these courses that allow concurrent enrollment with ENGL 098. IS: This integrated reading and writing cornerstone course develops contextualized applications of skills and strategies necessary for academic and career success. Areas of focus include critical thinking and research processes, with emphasis on relevancy and transfer to academic courses and career goals. Concurrent enrollment in SOCL120 or PSYC200 or BUSN118 is required. After registering for ENGL098, students should register for one of the following pairs of Academic Support labs and classes: NCAS103/SOCL120; NCAS104/PSYC200; or NCAS105/BUSN118. (Start with an NCAS lab to see information on the paired course). Co-enrollment in ACAD100 is also recommended. Students are encouraged to meet with an Academic Advisor for further information.
