		 Additional notes after TRT report and showing on last revision of 01.13.23: 	
		 revision of 01.13.23: Oops, apologies for missing these earlier, but 1) the verb in "Notes" is not correct: "The student's grade can raise in relationship to successfully completing additional competencies in any category"and 2) that "in relationship to" doesn't actually show the causality I know you intend either. See, "raise" is a transitive verb, meaning its action goes through, or transits, to an object—you can raise a flag, or <i>someone</i> can raise someone else's grade, or any X can be raised by a Y—but the current construction would take an intransitive verb, meaning that the object just does itself, if you see what I mean. "Rise" is an intransitive verb, such that the sun can rise or a person can rise in the morningbut of course that sort of by-itself-ism isn't what you intend here. Moreover, like I say, "in relationship to" I guess means sorta "because" here, but it doesn't seem strong enough, and most likely there's a tighter phrase anyway. Here is my guess on your intent for 1) and 2): "The student's grade can be improved by [increased by/raised by (?)] successfully completing additional competencies in any category" (?). Oops, 'nother one, in last paragraph of "Notes": 3) "however" is not a coordinating conjunction, meaning it cannot connect sentences with only a comma like "and" or "but" can. If you want to keep the "however," just shift the comma before it to a semicolon. A different way would be to leave the comma, shift the word to "but" instead, and then delete the comma after it.
