So, if a student submits their project ~20 days past "midway through the semester" they would receive a 0% on the project? Hypothetical. If I want to pass the course, I'm required to submit the project. However, if I submit the project ~20 days late, I receive a 0%. But, at least I have the opportunity to complete the course? This policy seems strange. I would remove the 5% penalty per day. I'm not opposed to a missed/tripwire-fail assignment, but I doubt that "complete" is the right term. Someone without this project can get only 1.5? 0.0? Incomplete? I think this must be clarified. Nicole asked for some clarification on the questions above so she can take it back to the faculty. What is pass? What the requirement to "complete" the course. So what on the syllabus does this pertain? None of the percentages or list of eval methods are changing, just the notes. James, Notes does not need to go through CC for approval. Nicole, that is correct, she just learned that.
